TWENTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

“But who do you say that I Am?” Simon Peter said in reply, “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.” Peter made the dramatic pronouncement about who Jesus was. Jesus called Simon Peter—upon whom the foundation of his Church would rest. We must strive to be like Peter, not only recognizing who Jesus is, but professing our faith openly. In what ways do we openly profess our faith?

Sacrarium

This is a special sink installed in the sacristy, usually right next to the regular sink. The sacrarium does not drain into the sewer, but goes directly into the ground. It is used to dispose of the water that has been used to purify the vessels after Holy Communion. Usually it has a cover so people will not inadvertently dispose of other things there. The wash water goes down the regular sink.

As you may have heard, Incarnation Parish now has a Parish App. Until I came to Incarnation Parish I had never used an iPhone, iPad, or an app. From my own experience it is very easy to use. The advantage of having this new form of technology is that it will allow us to have greater communication, evangelization, catechesis, and efficiency. Right now the app has a signup form for Mass servers, calendars for Youth Group, PREP, and the Parish as well as many more features to come.

The schedule for the servers is already functioning on the App along with other features like the Pastor thought of the week to name one. For example, the parents of the servers are able to go onto the server schedule form and pick the mass dates and times which they would want their child to serve. This is the first time using this style of signup and overall has been a smooth transition.

If you would like to sign up for the app, here is the way to do it. The developers of the app want to assure you that the registration step is a necessary security measure to protect our activities and data. The Incarnation app is free but unlike other free mobile apps, your account data is not going to be sold or be made available to anyone outside of our parish staff. Our app will not increase your digital footprint.

The Incarnation App is easy to download, simply go to the Apple App Store and type in “Incarnation” and then download our app to your iPad or iPhone. Or enter the following link from your iPhone or iPad.

Then, register to the app by clicking on the “Create new Account” text on the front login page. You will be sent a confirmation e-mail to confirm your registration. Click on the Activate Account Button on the e-mail you receive.
