What are you looking for: financial security or material possessions? love, power or position? a true friend or marriage partner? to be a good parent or spouse? We are all looking for someone or something to give our life meaning, purpose and joy. *We give an indication of our answer by the choices we make and the things we do each day.*

Also in today's Gospel we learn about one of at least two family relations that appear among Jesus' first disciples. Andrew is the brother of Simon, whom Jesus renames Peter. In next week's Gospel, we will learn about the brothers James and John, the sons of Zebedee. We know from the letters of Paul and other witnesses to the early Church that it was a common occurrence for an entire household to be baptized together.
