Sanctuary Lamp

As Catholics we are used to looking for the sanctuary lamp when we enter a church. It indicates where the tabernacle is and that Christ is present in the Blessed Sacrament reserved within it. From the Mass on Holy Thursday until the Easter Vigil Mass, the tabernacle is empty and the sanctuary lamp is unlit. Frequently the sanctuary lamp is suspended, but it can be free standing. The colored glass surrounding the flame is usually red. One other name I have heard for it is the "presence lamp." In many ways that seems like a more descriptive name.

The registration step is a necessary security measure to protect our activities and data. Our app is free but unlike other free mobile apps, your account data is not going to be sold or be made available to anyone outside of our parish staff. Our app will not increase your digital footprint!
