## IT IS TIME FOR CATCH THE BUILDING SPIRIT

- What is CtBS? Twenty years ago, a coalition of Catholic parishes in the Dayton Deanery got together with local Presbyterian churches and partnered with Dayton Ohio's Habitat for Humanity (HH) to build quality homes at cost for low-income families. Today, there are 20 Catholic churches and 10 Presbyterian churches involved.
- The purpose? As Christian Catholics, we critically need to stop urban decay by promoting affordable home ownership for families to gain financial equity. Substandard area housing affects 40% of our low-income urban households.
- How is the program funded and supported? Habitat for Humanity donates the lot for the home to be built in the Dayton area. It is the responsibility of the coalition of churches to raise money for the building of the home. All monies to fund the building and landscaping of the home come directly from the donations collected by the coalition of churches and not from Habitat for Humanity. Volunteers from the churches involved are also needed for carpentry, painting, pouring concrete, installing drywall, wiring, plumbing and planting grass and bushes. Whatever your talents, there is a place for you.
- Is the house a gift? No. The families are carefully screened and the occupant family has to attend classes on home ownership, demonstrate an ability to pay based on their income, and do a significant number of hours of community service to qualify for the purchase of the home. The program is administered by Habitat for Humanity and the home is sold to the qualifying family in accordance with HH rules.
- How you can help: Incarnation's donation appeal will be on Sat, June 9 and Sun, June 10. CtBS donation envelopes will be available at the end of each of the pews and can be returned in the following weeks collection. Checks are to be made payable to Incarnation Church.
